The Government is committed to translate these objectives into action, and looks forward to working with other key stakeholders in PNG, to grasp the opportunities of the information economy for the benefit of its entire people.

Telecommunication Deregulation Blueprint:

This document provides blueprint for the deregulation of the Papua New Guinea Telecommunication market. Further the document provides detail on structure, deregulation and landscape for the deregulated PNG telecommunication market. It should be used as a basis for effecting the various changes to policy, regulation and company structure to facilitate the implementation of the deregulation.


